Prom / Homecoming Proposals Form

While the Discovery High School Administration definitely wants students to attend Prom / Homecoming and enjoy the activity as much as possible, no administrator, teacher or staff member may support or encourage an activity that could disrupt school or lead to the violation of school rules, including being late to class.

Guidelines:

- If a student wants to ask another student to the prom, **the student needs to get prior approval from the principal.**
- If the prom proposal is approved by the principal, the principal will work with the student to provide the student with specific guidelines (e.g., location, time/date, duration, use of music and other effects) that the student must follow to avoid disciplinary action.
- School administration is required by district policy to address any actions that result in **blocked hallways, crowding, tardiness to class, or the violation of other school rules.**
